REGULATIONS AND BY-LAWS

- 1.0 The Club is affiliated with the Western Australian Hockey Association Inc, otherwise known as Hockey WA.
- 2.0 All members must be registered with the Club, who shall in turn register them with Hockey WA.
- 3.0 The official Club colours are green and yellow.
- 4.0 The official Club logo is;



- 5.0 Approved Club Uniform;
 - 5.1 Tops
Green and yellow in approved club design
 - 5.2 Shorts / Skirts / Skorts
Green or black.
- 6.0 Other than the office holders, as defined in the Constitution rule 29(3), the following shall constitute the minimum ordinary committee member positions;
 - 6.1 Mens vice-president
The men's vice-president shall have responsibility for organising all men's grades and players gradings, liaising with men's team organisers / captains, and dealing with all general playing related issues that may arise.
 - 6.2 Womens vice-president
The women's vice-president shall have responsibility for organising all women's grades and players gradings, liaising with women's team organisers / captains, and dealing with all general playing related issues that may arise.
 - 6.3 Junior vice-president
The junior vice-president shall have responsibility for organising all juniors grades and players gradings, liaising with junior team / age group organisers, and dealing with all general playing related issues that may arise.
- 7.0 The committee may appoint additional committee roles as needed for the performance of its duties.
- 8.0 The Club shall hold a minimum of 6 committee meetings (not including the Annual General Meeting) per year. These shall normally be held on a monthly basis, but may be more or less frequent at the determination of the committee or the president.



9.0 In addition to ordinary and life members, the Club has the following associate membership classes;

9.1 Patrons

The committee may appoint any persons of distinguished position or attainment to be the Patron(s) of the club. Said appointment shall last until the next annual general meeting unless resigned or revoked prior.

9.2 Junior members

Any person under the age of 18 may apply for admission as a junior member.

9.3 Social members

Any non playing person may apply for admission as a social member.
